● Requirements for admission

- Hold a Bachelor's degree (180 ECTS) or equivalent degree in philosophy.
- Candidates with a Bachelor's degree in another subject (social science, scientific field) must provide documented interest in the field of philosophy of biology or medicine.
- Proficiency in English is required. Candidates should have adequate knowledge of written and spoken English, equivalent to C1 according to the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR).

● Program duration & level

- 2 years (120 ECTS).
- Master's degree.
